What is MAP-21?

Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act (MAP-21) is the new federal transportation bill that contains the Transportation Alternatives (TA) program. This TA program is the source for a portion of the funding available to projects that focus on the needs of bicyclists and pedestrians to travel safely.
