Chanute, KS
9 and 30 mile courses

The **NCCC Relay for Life Team** is proud to invite you to join us for the **FIRST EVER RIDE FOR LIFE BICYCLE TOUR**. This event is sponsored by the NCCC Relay for Life team, with the assistance of local volunteers, as a charity event to raise funds for cancer research.

The **9 mile** course will take you from the NCCC parking lot to Santa Fe Park, along 35th to Plummer north to 21st, west on 21st one mile, north one mile, east on 7th to the airport and follow the bike trail back to Plummer and across at 14th to NCCC. Riders on this course should be sure they can negotiate a few hills as well as the distance.

The **30 mile** course will take you from the NCCC parking lot, past Santa Fe Park, to the city of Shaw, back to 35th and west to Plummer. Follow Plummer to 21st, west on 21st for one mile then north to 7th Street, east on 7th to the airport. After the airport, the route follows the bike path back to the college. Riders on this course should be sure they can negotiate several hills as well as the distance.

The **RIDE FOR LIFE BICYCLE TOUR** takes place on paved City and County roads in Chanute and the surrounding area. It is a great opportunity to see nature and enjoy fresh air with a healthy dose of exercise.

The entry fee for the 9 mile course is **\$15**. The entry fee for the 30 miles course is **\$20.00** (Rates subject to change) Included with your entry fee will be the water stops, sag service, and a **RIDE FOR LIFE BICYCLE TOUR** T-shirt. To insure receiving a T-shirt on the day of the ride, your pre-registration form must be received by April 6, 2010. **ALL RIDERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR A HELMET. THE NCCC RELAY FOR LIFE TEAM IS NOT REponsible FOR ACCIDENTS.**

All courses will begin and end at the NCCC South parking lot outside the Student Union. It is located 3 ½ blocks east of Plummer on 14th Street or 5 blocks west of McDonald's on 14th Street.

In case of rain, the ride will be delayed in 15 minute increments until 10:00 a.m. If the weather is still too inclement to ride, the 30 mile ride will be canceled and the 9 mile ride will be postponed until 12:00 noon. If at noon, the weather is still too bad to ride, the event will be canceled and all entry fees will be considered donations to Relay for Life. WAIVER STATEMENT

In consideration of the acceptance of my registration in the 2010 Ride For Life, I hereby freely agree to and make the following contractual representatives and agreements. I fully realize the dangers of participating in a bicycle ride and fully assume the risks associated with such participation including, by way of example, and not limitation, the following: the dangers of collision with pedestrians, vehicles, other riders and fixed or moving objects : the dangers arising from surface hazards, equipment failure, inadequate safety equipment and weather conditions.

- I hereby waive, release and discharge for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, assigns and successors in interest (hereinafter collectively “successors”) any and all rights which I have or which may hereafter accrue to me against the sponsors of this event, the organizers and any promoting organization(s), property owners, law enforcement agencies, all public entities, special districts, and properties (and their respective agents, officials and employees) through which the event will be held for any and all damages which may be sustained by me of directly or indirectly in connection with, or arising out of, my participation in or association with the event, travel to or return from the event.
- I agree it is my sole responsibility to be familiar with the ride course, and special regulations for the event. I understand and agree that situations may arise during the ride, which may be beyond the immediate control of the ride officials, or organizers and I must continually ride so not to endanger myself or others. I accept responsibility for the condition and adequacy of my equipment. I will wear an ANSI or SNELL approved helmet and will adhere to the rules of the road while riding in this event.
- I agree, for myself and successors, that the above representatives are contractually binding, and are not mere recitals and that I or my successors shall be liable for the expenses (including legal fees) incurred by the other party or parties in defending, unless the other party / parties are finally adjudged liable on such claim for willful and wanton negligence. This agreement may not be modified orally, and a waiver of any provision shall not be construed as a modification of any other provision herein or as consent to any subsequent waiver of modification.
